Climate conditions

The 2021 vintage was marked by varied and challenging weather conditions, with little rainfall throughout the year. The winter was marked by sub-zero temperatures, mostly in February. March was dry with above-average temperatures, which favored the budding of the vines. After a cool, wet spring, a high-pressure system in late May brought more stability to the weather, ensuring dry conditions until the end of August, when a pleasant rain brought freshness to both the air and the soil. September was warm and sunny, allowing the grapes to be harvested at optimum phenolic maturity. The grapes for Aria di Caiarossa are selected from our highest vineyards in Nocolino, with a unique soil composition of stones, marne, and volcanic soil. This terroir ensures greater minerality and a solid structure.

Winemaking

Harvest:

The harvest, completely carried out by hand, began with the Merlot Nocolino on September the 2nd and ended with the Cabernet Sauvignon "Belvedere" from Nocolino vineyard on September the 18th.

Vinification:

Varieties from each parcel are vinified separately in wooden and concrete tanks, with slow fermentations and soft extractions.

Ageing:

Once the malolactic fermentation is completed, the wine selected for Aria di Caiarossa is blended. Then it ages approximately 13 months in french oak barriques, using 20% of new oak.

Alcohol:

14,5%.

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
